Recommended Packet Order

Based on currently available packets as of Summer 2019

Order Note: Many schools allow students to pick whichever packet they want to do next, so long as everyone starts with the Sh'ma packet.

Holiday Packets Note: I recommend starting the Chanukah & Passover Packets 3 sessions before the holiday and ask students to put their "regular" packets on hold until they finish the holiday packet.

1. Sh'ma
 - a. Reasoning: Pretty much everyone already knows the Sh'ma, so students can learn how to learn from the packets with a familiar prayer before moving on to less-familiar prayers.
